Plants & Seasonal Changes

The United Kingdom





Reading & Writing

In English we will:

- read Billy and The Beast and On The Way Home
- write simple stories in the third person
- write a revolting recipe inspired by Billy and The Beast
- write instructions for how to get home





Maths

We will be learning to:

- read, write, represent, compare and order numbers up to 50
- explore addition and subtraction involving 2-digit numbers
- investigate number bonds within 20
- name coins and notes and understand their value
- represent the same value using different coins

Science

We will be learning to:

- identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants
- observe how plants change over a period of time
- observe changes across seasons
- make weekly observations and record results using photographs, tables and labelled diagrams

Geography

We will be learning about:

- human features within the different countries in The United Kingdom
- how to identify characteristics of The United Kingdom and its surrounding areas

PE

Year 1 has a PE lesson every **Tuesday** and **Thursday**.

Please ensure your child comes to school in their school PE kit on these days.

The focus of our PE lessons this half term is running, jumping and throwing. We will use these skills during Sports Day in Summer 2.

RE & PSHE

In **RE**, we will continue our focus on Christian Beliefs. We will discuss issues of right and wrong from bible stories.

In **PSHE**, we will learn about relationships with our friends and relationships in families. We will identify what it means to be a good friend and learn to recognise individual qualities in one another.

Design Technology

Our focus will be textiles. We will make simple dolls.

We will learn:

- how to create and use paper templates
- how to pin a template to fabric before cutting it out
- ways to join fabric including stapling and gluing
