

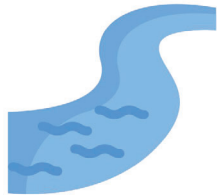
Year 3 Curriculum leaflet Summer 1



Plants and their Life Cycles



Rivers



Reading & Writing

In English we will be:

- reading SFA/RWI books at our level to develop our fluency and comprehension
- writing poetry, a non-chronological report and a persuasive article inspired by *A River* by Marc Martin and *Rhythm of the Rain* by Grahame Baker-Smith



Maths

We will be learning to:

- tell the time using both analogue and digital clocks
- identify right angles and recognise that they are a quarter turn
- draw, make, classify and compare 2D and 3D shapes
- estimate mass and capacity
- read scales with different intervals

Science

We will be learning to:

- identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers
- investigate the way in which water is transported within plants
- explore the requirements of plants for life and growth and how they vary from plant to plant

Geography

We will be learning about:

- how rivers are formed and features of rivers
- the factors that cause flooding and the impact of floods
- names and locations of the five longest rivers in the UK
- the role of flood barriers

PE

3G have a PE lesson every **Tuesday** and **Friday**. 3B have a PE lesson every **Thursday** and **Friday**. Please ensure the children wear a PE kit on those days.

The focus of the sessions will be athletics.



RE & PSHE

This term our focus will be on **prayer** and **relationships**.

We will be learning to:

- make connections between beliefs and behaviours across different religions
- identify roles and responsibilities of family members and reflect upon changes over time

Art & Design

We will be focusing on animated drawing. We will learn:

- how to draw different poses that show movement
- to animate drawings to make moving images
- to use puppetry to make our drawings move
