Physical Development

We will continue to develop our gross motor skills through dance and movement inspired by the cultures we are learning about. We are securing our scissors skills. Let your child be creative with scissors and recycled materials at home.

Understanding the World

We will learn about life in other countries with a different climate. We will grow plants and observe how nature comes to life in Spring.

Help your child sow seeds and grow some easy care plants, such as herbs. Talk about the growth process and take pictures to share with us.

Maths

We will focus on understanding that numbers represent a set of objects and learn to count with accuracy. We will explore patterns inspired by colourful African clothes. Point out numbers and patterns all

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Literacy

We will continue to develop our story telling skills by acting out the characters in our core books as a group. We will continue to develop our pencil control to mark make. Encourage your child to practise some letters in their name correctly.

Communication & Language

We will learn new poems and songs inspired by the cultures we are learning about.

Teach your child some of your old favourite nursery rhymes or childhood songs.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will learn to take more responsibility for our learning by setting goals to work towards both at home and at nursery.

Encourage your child to help out around the house and praise them for their hard work.

Expressive Art & Design

We will explore animals sounds that are inspired by our core stories and use instruments to match their pitch. We will mix media to create scenes inspired by the story settings, such as a rainforest or a savannah. Sing along to the rhyme of the week with your child every week.
