



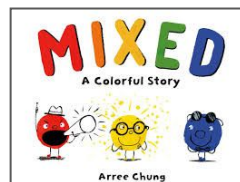
Nursery - Summer 1

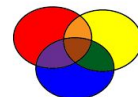

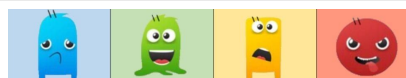

Key Experiences

Maths

Play board games at home and practice counting the dots on the die.

Communication & Language

We will use topic specific vocabulary accurately to describe what happens when a plant is growing, being able to name it's different parts.

Physical Development

We will continue to work hard on being able to write our name independently, ensuring we hold our pencil correctly.

Practice writing your child's name at home in a variety of fun ways, e.g. in rice or in shaving foam

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will talk about our feelings using words such as 'happy' and 'worried' and think about activities that make us feel those feelings.

Encourage your child to express themselves during moments of frustration using their words.

Understanding the World

We will explore the life-cycle of plants and observe our own plants as they grow.

Take your child on a nature walk and talk to them about all the different things that are starting to grow now it's summer.

Literacy

We will continue to learn new letter sounds and start using these sounds to blend words, e.g. c-a-t = cat.

Practice recognising each weeks sound when you are out and about, e.g. look for them on street signs.

Expressive Art & Design

We will explore the different combinations of colours and what happens when we mix them. We will create a variety of interesting artworks using different materials and mediums.

Encourage your child to explore using colours to express themselves
