



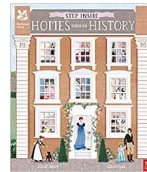
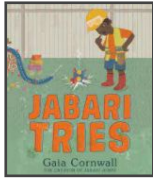
# Reception - Summer 2

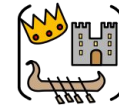

## Literacy - Writing

## Maths

We will be adding and subtracting numbers to 20 and representing them in different ways.

Practise counting back and forth to 20 and beyond.

## Understanding the World

We will be learning about the evolution of our homes and how technology has changed the way we live now.

Talk to your child about school, toys and other everyday objects when you were a child and how they have changed over time.

## Expressive Art & Design

We will create our own models in a pair or as a whole group to develop our creative and collaborative skills.
