Knowledge I already have

In Reception:

- I learned that we live in a city called London.

New Knowledge

This half term:

- I am learning the names of the four countries that make up the United Kingdom and their capital cities.
- I am learning the names and locations of the four seas surrounding the United Kingdom.
- I am learning the four points on a compass: North, East, South and West.
- I am learning how to describe locations and directions.
- I am learning how to read a simple map and add details to it.
- To identify human and physical features in the local area.

Future Knowledge

Later in Year 1:

- I will learn more about London, the city I live in.
- I will draw my own maps. To name and locate the capital cities and surrounding seas of the United Kingdom.
- I will identify key human and physical features within the four countries of the United Kingdom.
- I will learn about the weather within the four countries of the United Kingdom.

- I will use a map and directions to navigate around my local area.
- I will collect information about people's favourite places to go.
