## Key Vocabulary

### contrast

To show the differences between two or more things



In this topic we are contrasting the physical and geographical features of Hackney and Alexandria.

### locate

The find the exact place or position of something

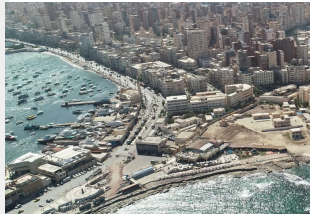


We can locate Hackney and Alexandria on a map



### city

A large settlement with lots of people living there.



London is a city in England and Alexandria is a city in Egypt.



### farm

An area of land and its buildings used for growing crops and/or rearing animals.



Farms are generally found in the countryside (rural areas) but they can also be found in cities.

There are farms in both Alexandria and Hackney.

### harbour

A place on the coast that is protected where ships and boats can be safely secured.



There are two harbours in Alexandria Port: East and West.



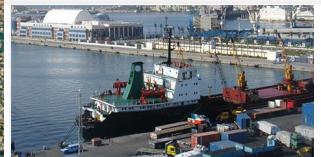
### port

A town or city with a harbour.



Ships take on or unload cargo in a port.

Alexandria is a **port city**.



### How this connects with previous learning
