Dear Grazebrook families,

Following on from my letter containing Public Health England Coronavirus-19 guidance this afternoon, I am writing to let you know that **from Monday 15th November**, the school will be putting in place some additional measures to limit the transmission of the virus within the school community:

- A thorough whole school deep clean organised for this weekend;
- Whole school gatherings such as assemblies will be virtual;
- Staff gatherings will be minimised with staff meetings and training moving online;
- Use of the staff room will be restricted and social distancing in shared spaces will be reintroduced;
- Staff will be advised to wear face masks in communal spaces;
- We strongly recommend families wear masks on site;
- All staff will continue with twice weekly lateral flow testing;
- Children will be reminded to sanitise or wash hands throughout the day.

Unfortunately we will be postponing the travelling book fair and the Reception and Year 3 reading breakfasts. We will closely monitor the situation and let you know if any further events need to be cancelled or moved on-line. These measures will stay in place until we receive further advice from Public Health England.

Thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation as we work hard to keep our school community safe.
