Dear Families,

As you are aware, New Wave Federation has been working in partnership with Thomas Fairchild Community School since September 2021. We established this partnership in order to ensure the future of Thomas Fairchild as a local primary and to raise the standard of education for its pupils. In collaboration with the local authority, New Wave Federation has made significant progress in re-establishing Thomas Fairchild as a school that serves its community and provides excellent educational opportunities for all.

As part of this process of regeneration, the Governing Board is unanimous in recommending Thomas Fairchild Community School become a full member of the New Wave Federation and not just a partner. A period of formal consultation will now take place to consider the views of parents in all our schools. We are proposing that a formal partnership would begin from the **1st of September 2023**.
