

Attendance/Punctuality



- The school day begins promptly at 8:55am for full time children and morning children. Afternoon children should arrive at 12.30pm. Being late can be stressful for children. They will also miss valuable teaching time.
- Morning sessions end at 11.55am. Afternoon sessions end at 3:30pm. Please try to be punctual and call the office if you are running late.
- Please let us know if someone different is collecting your child.
- If your child is absent due to illness or any other reason, please phone the school in the morning to let us know.
- Please avoid holidays in school time. These will not be authorised and will impact on your child's learning.



Wraparound Care



- Breakfast club is available for Nursery pupils on request from 8am Monday to Friday.
- We provide Early Years extended day childcare until 6pm. This is separate from 'Our Space' which is for pupils from Years 1 to 6. Children are provided with a healthy snack and activities vary each day.
- All wraparound care needs to be booked through the school office and paid for in advance.
- Before school care costs £2/day and after school care costs £10/day.




Clothes for Nursery/Uniform



- You may choose to send your Nursery child to school in school uniform, but this is not compulsory.
- We wear black shoes or black trainers.
- Please label all your child's belongings and possessions. It saves a lot of time and allows us to quickly identify mislaid clothing.
- On a PE day, please send your child into school in PE kit or sports clothes including trainers.
- If your child is unable to participate in P.E., please let a member of the Nursery team know on the day.






Snacks and lunches



- Children are encouraged to bring in a named water bottle which is kept at the side of the classroom and accessed throughout the day.
- Please remember if your child will be having packed lunch, we are an allergy friendly school and so we ask that you don't pack any **nut or egg** products. Please inform us of any allergies or medication requirements your child may have.
- Children are not allowed to bring money, sweets or any valuables to school.



Injuries and medical




- The school will contact parents or carers if your child is taken ill or has a serious injury. We also contact parents if your child has a head injury, no matter how trivial. For minor injuries you will receive an accident slip at the end of the day.
- It is school policy that medicine is not administered in school unless prescribed by a doctor. If your child requires any special medicine such as an inhaler or any other prescription medicine, you must fill out a medicine form at the school office.
