Dear Grazebrook families,

At Grazebrook, we are keen to provide children with experiences which will teach them lifelong skills both inside and outside the classroom, one of which is gardening and experiencing eating produce which they have grown themselves.

Last year, the PSA donated the funds to create a well-being garden which included building and planting six raised beds outside the Year 6 classrooms. All children have access to this space which is used for calming activities including gardening. It is a space where children can regulate their emotions and support their well-being. The space is also used to support delivering our wider curriculum including our work as an Eco-School.

We have a number of enthusiastic gardeners who would like to continue to make the green spaces in our school an enjoyable place for the children and families of our school community and as such would now like to enhance the garden project further. To do this we would like the following:

- A new garden shed as the current one is rotting and falling apart
- Workshops with Woodshop of Recycled Delight to create a garden bench and mud kitchen
- Gardening Supplies (e.g. seeds, plants, composter, waterbutt)

Our wishlist comes to around **£2,500**.

With the help of parents and staff, we are organising two fundraising events. These events will take place on **Friday 8th March and Friday 10th May from 3:30 - 4:00pm**. These events will include a **bake & cake sale, flower stall and pre-loved uniform stall**.
