In the table below are the National Curriculum end of year expectations for times tables for each year group.

Year 1	Step counting in multiples of 2, 5, and 10.
Year 2	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
Year 3	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4, and 8 times tables.
Year 4	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 x 12 .
Year 5	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 x 12 .
Year 6	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 x 12 .
