All children **MUST** attend school on these days and arrive punctually. To support children to be ready for the tests each day, we will be providing a free breakfast club on the 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th of May. A letter with further details about SATs week will be sent next week.

All early morning and after school boosters will run until SATs. The final day for these is Friday 6th May.

Thank you for continuing to ensure your child arrives at school each day no later than 8.55am, dressed in the Grazebrook uniform including appropriate footwear.
