### Year 6 PGL Liddington Update



In preparation for our upcoming PGL adventure from **Monday 23rd to Friday 27th March 2026**, we are sharing some key reminders, including essential items your child will need to bring, important medication information and a preview of our travelling arrangements. #### Medication:

**Please continue to inform us of any medication your child takes at home or overnight, even if it is not usually needed in school. This includes (but is not limited to):**

- Inhalers
- Antihistamines
- Pain relief
- Creams
- Bladder control or sleeping aids



#### Important reminders:

- Please do not surprise us with unreported medication on departure day as we may not be able to accommodate your child on the residential;
- Only GP prescribed medication can be administered (except travel sickness tablets or vitamin supplements);
- Supporting paperwork from your GP, hospital or clinic is required;
- Medication details must match your child's medical consent form;
- Do not pack any medication in your child's suitcase;
- A permission to administer medication form must be also be completed in advance;
- All medication will be managed safely by the lead first aider and will be handed in to them on arrival at school on Monday 23rd March.

#### What to Pack – Essential Items:

Please do not buy new or expensive items – comfort and warmth are key. Children are likely to get muddy which is why we suggest sending your child with some spare items.

- 2 x waterproof jacket / warm coat
- 5 x jumpers or sweatshirts
- 5 x trousers (no jeans)
- 6 x T-shirts
- 10 x socks
- 10 x underwear
- Pyjamas
- Hat, scarf and gloves
- Disco or special outfit
- Washbag and toiletries
- 1 x towel
- 1 x additional footwear / trainers
- Plastic/cloth bag/s for dirty clothes

#### What to take - Suggested items

- Pens/pencils
- Note/Colouring Book
- Waterproof trousers/Wellies
- Books/Comics
- Playing Cards/Travel games

#### What not to take.

**Mobiles, tablets, games consoles or gadgets of any kind on the trip. Any electronic items that are brought to PGL will be taken and kept by an adult until the children return to school on the evening of Friday 27th March.**

### Pocket Money - our Gift Shop visit

- Children may bring a maximum of £20.00;
- Money should be handed in on Monday 23rd March in a **named envelope (we will have spares at school if you don't have one at home)**;
- Money will be given out during our gift shop visit;
- Any change will be returned on arrival back at school;
- There are lots of small mementos available as well as a range of treats and snacks;

### Family Information Session - optional:

**Wednesday 4th March 2026 at 8.30am in The Main Hall**

In this session, we will go through the information shared in the slides in more detail. We will also answer any additional questions you may have.

### Travel Arrangements

Departure - Monday 23rd March

- Children should arrive at school no later than 8.45am to check in!
- One suitcase and one small bag/backpack containing a packed lunch
- School packed lunches are available on request
- Coach departs at approximately 10.00am
- Please let us know if your child suffers from travel sickness

Journey details:

- Approximately 2-3 hours, depending on traffic
- Toilet stop included if required
- Packed lunches must not contain sweets, fizzy drinks, sesame or nuts - let's keep our children with allergies safe

Return - Friday 27th March

- Estimated arrival back at school: 5.00pm
- We will update families by text on the day due to travelling back through rush hour traffic
