Dear Year 6 Families,

I am writing to you regarding the upcoming SATs (Standard Assessment Tests) for your child. The children have been working incredibly hard all year and we are extremely proud of them all. This important week will allow them to showcase their efforts and the excellent progress they have made.

The SATs tests will begin on **Monday 11th May** and will follow this schedule:

- **Monday 11th May:** English grammar, punctuation and Spelling Papers 1 and 2
- **Tuesday 12th May:** English reading
- **Wednesday 13th May:** Mathematics Papers 1 and 2 (arithmetic and reasoning Part 1)
- **Thursday 14th May:** Mathematics Paper 3

Attendance during SATs week is extremely important for all Year 6 pupils, as these assessments are a statutory requirement. To ensure that all children are in school and are ready for the tests to start at 9.00am, we will be extending the Year 6 school day during the four days of the testing.

All Year 6 children are invited to attend a free breakfast club from 8.15am, running from **Monday 11th May until Thursday 14th May**. If your child prefers to eat at home, please ensure they arrive at school between 8.30am and 8.45am. **All children must be on site by 8.45am** to allow time to settle and prepare for the tests.

We would also like to invite all families to a Year 6 SATS meeting on **Friday 1st May from 9.10-9.30am in the main hall**, should you have any questions about the SATs, access arrangements or breakfast provision.
