Safeguarding Alert - Squid Game

It has come to our attention that some children are watching a Netflix series called Squid Game. The plot centres on a group of adults competing against each other in a series of childhood games. However, the losing competitors in these games are then violently killed off in ways that grow more twisted as the games progress.

The show is rated 15+, but even if children's Netflix accounts have the necessary age restrictions, clips from the show are also circulating on social media platforms like TikTok and YouTube. If you are aware that your child has seen this show or you have heard them speaking about it, please have a conversation with them about the concerns of watching content that is not age-appropriate. Please also remind them that if they do view anything they shouldn't have, then they should speak with an adult and not share what they have seen with others in school.
